WORDS OF CAUTION

Brethren,

I hope this message finds you well. I want to take a moment to address a recent situation involving a mailed threat directed at one of our sister lodges within the district. While there is no immediate or specific threat to Hightstown-Apollo Lodge, it is our duty to stay vigilant and proactive to ensure the safety and peace of mind of all our members and visitors.

To that end, we are implementing the following precautionary measures:

- 1. Installation of Security Cameras: We will be installing security cameras around the lodge property. These will serve not only as a deterrent against vandalism or any unwanted activity but also as a way to help safeguard everyone who enters our doors.
- 2. Strict Door Security: All exterior doors will remain locked during all events—this includes our Thursday fellowship nights and any other informal gatherings. Entry should only be granted by a brother who recognizes and admits the visitor.
- 3. Seeing Each Brother Out: Whenever possible, we will accompany one another out of the lodge after meetings or events. This simple gesture enhances safety and brotherhood.

Let me be clear—this is not a cause for alarm or fear. There is no known threat to Hightstown-Apollo specifically. These steps are taken out of responsibility and care, not panic. Unfortunately, misinformation and conspiracy theories online can create unnecessary fear. I urge each of you to stay grounded, cautious, and focused on what truly matters—our fraternal bond and the well-being of our Lodge.

Above all, I want to say that I feel safe and proud to stand alongside each of you. Your presence, brotherhood, and strength make this lodge a sanctuary of fellowship and Light.


