Brothers,

It calls us to honesty in our dealings, integrity in our choices, and courage in our convictions. Truth also demands humility: the understanding that the work is never finished, and that self-improvement is a lifelong labor.

Equally sacred is respect for the Craft—the care we give to ritual, the dignity we bring to our conduct, and the attention we offer when a Brother speaks. These are not formalities; they are signs that we value something greater than ourselves.

When these principles are practiced with intention, the lodge becomes more than a meeting—it becomes a workshop of character, where men are strengthened, friendships are deepened, and purpose is renewed. In practicing Masonry well, we learn not only how to be better Brothers, but better men, husbands, fathers, neighbors, and citizens.

The true measure of a Freemason is not how well he wears the apron, but how faithfully he lives the lessons it represents.




