Greetings from the East

I want to thank everyone again who came out and helped with the Official Visit and filled in for members who were unable to attend. Now we have to work toward the GLI in June, we could still be called upon to do an opening or closing so we will try and have a few practice days before then. Symbols are the root of our fraternity, so I hope you enjoy the following light on Masonic Symbols.

Light from the "East"

In the heart of a bustling city or small town, nestled among the towering skyscrapers or neighborhood homes, there stands an ancient building, its facade adorned with mysterious symbols. This is the meeting place of a centuries-old fraternity known as the Freemasons. Within its walls, members gather to share knowledge, wisdom, and camaraderie. But it is the symbols of Freemasonry that truly captivate those who enter.

At the entrance, a massive door greet members, adorned with intricate carvings of the square and compasses, the most recognizable symbol of Freemasonry. These tools, symbolic of virtue and morality, reminded all who entered of the importance of living a balanced and virtuous life. The "Square" represents morality, honesty, and integrity, reminding Masons to act ethically in their dealings with others. The "Compasses" symbolize selfrestraint, providing boundaries for behavior and actions. Together, they remind Masons to act within moral boundaries and to circumscribe their desires and keep their passions within due bounds.

Inside the lodge room, the walls are adorned with an array of symbols, each carrying its own significance.

The letter "G" hangs prominently above the master's chair, symbolizing both geometry, the basis of the craft, and God, the ultimate architect of the universe. Placed at the center of the Masonic emblem it represents the Supreme Being's presence, reminding Masons of the importance of spirituality and the divine in their lives. It reminds members that their work should be conducted with precision and under the watchful eye of the Creator.

As the meeting commenced, the Worshipful Master stood before his brethren. He spoke of the symbolism behind each emblem, urging his fellow Masons to embody the virtues they represented. For within these symbols lay the keys to enlightenment and self-improvement.

He explains that "The All-Seeing Eye" often depicted as an eye within a triangle, also represents the divine watchfulness of the Great Architect of the Universe. It symbolizes the presence of God and the importance of living a life under the ever-watchful eye of the divine.

The "Trowel" symbolizes brotherly love and affection. It reminds Masons to spread the cement of brotherly love and affection, uniting them in the bonds of friendship and fellowship.

The "Level" symbolizes equality and reminds Masons that, regardless of their social, economic, or cultural differences, they are all equal in the eyes of the Great Architect of the Universe.

The "Plumb" symbolizes uprightness of conduct and reminds Masons to walk uprightly in their dealings with others, always maintaining a strict adherence to moral and ethical principles.

And so, as the meeting drew to a close and the brethren departed, they carried with them not only the knowledge shared within those hallowed walls but also a deeper understanding of the timeless symbols that bind them together as Freemasons. For in those symbols lay the essence of their fraternity, guiding them on their journey towards truth and enlightenment.


