



Historical Light

The cover art for this Trestleboard is a full page plate from the very first NJ official *Manual for the Use of Lodges* published in 1887. The Manual contained 23 full page plates for the three degrees (10 EA, 5 FC, 8 MM) as visual prompts for degrees and lectures since written rituals, either coded or in plain text, were forbidden in those days.

This plate refers to the section of the EA lecture explaining the reasons for the ceremonies. Notice the various steps of the ceremony: Reception. Stations at the S, W & E. first step W of altar, or perhaps prayer. Altar, and presumably whatever happens there. along with greater and lesser lights. Signs (right angle, horizontal and perpendicular). Apron with flap up. Lamb (emblem of innocence). WT's. NE corner. The only thing I cannot fathom is the six circles in a triangle depicted in the upper right. It might somehow represent the demand, but what that has to do with six circles is beyond me. It has nothing to do with the form of the lodge since that is clearly represented on other plates. There is no written description because the whole point was to avoid print, paint, stamp, stain, cut, carve, etc.

Subsequent editions of NJ's official manual eliminated the pages of plates. The 1897 edition still had small illustrations interspersed in the text. By the 1919 edition, all illustrations were removed.

For those who are curious to read the complete original 1887 Official Manual, it can be viewed for free in the Internet Archive (Archive.org). It is a scanned copy of an original in the Rutgers library.
