MASTER'S MESSAGE

Freemasonry's ties to the White House and the American presidency are woven through history. Several U.S. presidents have been Freemasons, a fraternity based on principles of personal morality, mutual support, and commitment to society. These include George Washington, James Monroe, Andrew Jackson, James Polk, James Buchanan, Andrew Johnson, James Garfield, William McKinley, Theodore Roosevelt, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Harry S. Truman. Freemasonry's core values—brotherhood, charity, and truth—resonated with the principles upon which the United States was founded. As Masons, these leaders adhered to traditions of morality and civic responsibility that influenced their public lives.

One of the earliest and most prominent examples of Freemasonry in American government was when George Washington, a devoted Freemason, laid the cornerstone of the U.S. Capitol in 1793. This event symbolized the fraternity's deep connection to the new nation's democratic ideals. Washington's involvement in Freemasonry is often highlighted as a symbol of the values of unity, service, and integrity in public office.

Harry S. Truman, another Freemason, served as the Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Missouri before becoming president. Known for his strong leadership and straightforward demeanor, Truman credited many of his values and character to his Masonic principles. In the White House, these Masonic values have provided a moral framework for presidents seeking to uphold ethical standards while serving the public.

While Freemasonry's impact is still reflected in the architecture, symbols, and ceremonial traditions within Washington, D.C. The history of Freemasonry in the White House is a testament to the enduring values of self-improvement, civic duty, and unity that Freemasonry promotes and that have shaped American leadership for centuries.
